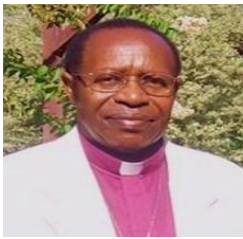


## **A VOICE OF ALL NATIONS**
