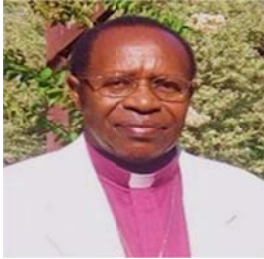


**A VOICE OF ALL NATIONS**

**1 Samuel 7:12**



July is the celebration of our anniversaries. The greatest surprise was the celebration of Silver anniversary of Kenya Christian Fellowship in America which was born in our home when we were ministering in Pensacola, Florida. The Lord allowed us to be with the fellowship for three years and then called us to other ministries. Twenty-two years later, he attracted us to the Annual National conference. We were invited by Dr. John and Josephine Nyaga, who paid all expenses. They did this to give us therapy because we were going through bereavement after the death of Mary's sister Jane and my sister Mary. Going there we were dumfounded by the development, life and energy of the sea of Kenyan Christian who were over one thousand. The music was inspiring and uplifting. The preachers were mighty servants of the Lord. Among them was Dr. Joseph Onyango Okello, Current President, who preach from the Book of Esther. His main theme was: "when God is silent, He is working behind the scene". He remarked that there is no name of God in the entire book of Esther. This was because God was silent and working behind the scene. Without note, he took us through sixty-six books of the Bible. Interestingly, KCFA was born when God was silent in our lives and I was asking Him "why questions". One of the question was: "why did you give me the discipline of work if you knew that one time I will be out of the pulpit? Then the Lord answered: "John Githiga, feed my sheep." "Where are they ?." I asked. "In your neighborhood." The lord answered. I then stared two fellowships which included white, yellow and black. And so when Dr. Joe Karogi, the founding President came with a team of Kenyan Christian and suggested that we start a fellowship, Mary and I were jubilant. Interesting, Mary Karogi reminded me something which I had forgotten. That we had Holy Communion in our house and that we had two cups. One with wine and the other one with grape juice. She noted that all those who used grape juice in their Church, took wine. This was a symbol of unity in diversity.
