A visit of Bishop Peter Palani was characterized by mutual impartation. We were surprised by so many gifts which he brought to us most of which had gospel messages. The key holders with messages: "Keep me as the apple of your eye." "from this day I will bless you;" "I am the Good Shepherd:" "God bless you." "For I am the Lord who heals." The most surprising gift was a pregnant elephant which reminded me of the dream I had when I was planning for the mission to India. In the dream, I saw myself carrying a live elephant on my back. In addition to the gifts, Peter surprised us when we were taking him for sightseeing at Paro Duro Park. He volunteered to pay for the entrance fees. The Lord enjoyed fulfilling his promise "Give and it shall be given unto you." The Seminary students most of who are refugees, gave Peter \$300 for three bikes for his pastors. After preaching and administering healing in a Congolese Congregation which is pastored by our Student, Eliazar, all of who are refugees with minimal income, donated 11 bikes for the Indian Pastors. Other donated money for the orphanage. One Congolese said; "Since you are my size and I have another suit and a pair of shoes, that will be my gifts to you." A lady said: "Since we love you so much and we want you to look smart, and I am a seller of suits, I will buy one suite for you." St. Cyprian's prepared consecration service and reception for Peter. We indeed experienced anointing of the Holy Spirit. Besides consecration, Patriarch, who is analytical psychologist, helped Peter to identify his personality type which is ISFJ: "if you are ISFJ you belong to 6 per cent of the population. Even though you appear quite, reserved, down -to- earth; you are sensible, orderly, neat, gentle, humane, super-dependable and you can be good....at ministering to the needy, marginalized and ignorant people" *Initiation and Pastoral Psychology* p155. Interesting, Bishop Peter ministers to the leper, blind, orphans and windows earning his living as a taxi driver. This indeed is Jesus ministry. When the John the Baptist sent his disciples to check out whether Jesus was the messiah, Jesus responded: "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf

hear, the dead are raised and the good news are being proclaimed to the poor.”
