RATIONALE

1. There is no one scholar who professes to know all the questions posed in Christology, but the study of Jesus and his work on earth serves as the eye opener and the heart of systematic theology and the theme of the whole Bible.
2. Rather than giving a speculative and philosophical course, a thorough research was done, to find out what the Bible says about Jesus Christ; and thereafter presenting a careful exegetical and scholarly analysis of key passages of Scripture on the subject.
3. A thorough treatment is given to the fulfillment of prophecy as it relates to Christ both in the past and the future. The main emphasis of the course is to discover exactly what scripture says about Jesus Christ.

OBJECTIVES

1. To understand and evaluate present and past doctrines pertaining to Christ and reject any of those that are not scriptural.
2. To relate Christology with other doctrines of the Bible, including doctrines of trinity and redemption.
3. To recognize the person and work of Jesus Christ in the Old Testament and apply them in your day to day teachings and preaching.
4. To evaluate and organize the facts concerning Christ's birth, life, death and resurrection and relate how they fit in overall plan of God.
5. To teach the biblical truth concerning deity and true humanity of Christ in the incarnation.
6. To understand and appreciate deeply Christ's incarnation, earthly ministry, provisions availed through death, and His resurrection.
7. To use sound biblical premises for your teaching and preaching Christ, stretching his ministry into the second coming and reveal His future heavenly ministry
